Nottingham Art Map Application Procedure

The Nottingham Art Map was founded in 2015 and developed in close dialogue with a range of visual art organisations from across the city of Nottingham. A steering group of representatives from these organisations continues to meet every four months to consider new applications; review membership of listed organisations and inform the onward development of the Art Map.

The Nottingham Art Map represents a cross-section of organisations across the city, that demonstrate a focus towards the contemporary visual art. The Art Map helps demonstrate the strength and diversity of the artistic landscape to both local, visiting and online audiences, whilst helping to define a shared identity and context between listed venues. The printed version of the Art Map carries venue information only, whilst the web version contains venue programme information. The intention is for readers to use the two platforms in unison.

It is essential for us that the Art Map is 'alive' and exists as an active signpost to programme based visual arts activity, as opposed to operating as a static venue directory. The Art Map will only list organisations that are predominantly associated with delivering a structured and consistent programme of public exhibitions and events.

It is vital for us that there is existing and ongoing engagement between hosted venues and there is a firm commitment to making an active and vital contribution to Nottingham's artistic community.

The Art Map is not intended to be a definitive guide to Nottingham's diverse artistic community, and recommends and signposts readers to other third party guides. We also recommend applicants consider other listing sources to determine what is most suited to their organisation.

- The Steering Committee will offer brief feedback on unsuccessful applications but will not enter into on onward dialogue relating to an outcome.
- Organisations are welcome to make repeat applications on a quarterly basis.
- If your application is accepted, then it will be periodically reviewed by the Steering Group in accordance with your original application form. On this basis, it is your responsibility to update us of circumstantial and organisational changes.
- It is the responsibility of the organisation to update programme information on the website, failure to consistently update your listing will trigger a review of your position on the Art Map.
- The Nottingham Art Map committee reserves the right to make decisions relating to organisations exclusion from the Art Map if the above conditions are not met.
